

If your Inkjet Fabric Sheets start to curl:

Exposure to the atmosphere, especially high humidity, can cause the fabric sheets to curl toward the fabric side, which can cause a paper jam in certain printers.

If a fabric sheet is curled, place a sheet of plain paper over the fabric (to keep it clean) and roll the fabric sheet against the direction of the curl, both lengthwise and then side to side. Hold the fabric sheet in a tube shape for as long as is necessary to offset the unwanted curl.

Alternatively, you can place a sheet of plain paper over the fabric (to keep it clean) and drag the fabric sheet's paper backing over the edge of a table to reverse the curl (similar to curling a piece of ribbon).

To prevent curling from happening in the first place, always keep the fabrics sealed in the zip bag they came in.
